WHAT DID HE TELL YOU?

We’ve found that a man’s answers to these questions are a fair guide to whether he wants to be in a relationship or not.* If he gives a male and a female name to each pair of animals, then he sees a world of couples and will feel most comfortable conforming to that. If on the other hand he gives a male name to each animal, it indicates he’s more likely to be into spending time with buddies. (Although, some people have asked us whether it’s a sign that he’s gay!) If he gives female names to each animal, then it suggests that he doesn’t feel a part of the female world. He may feel alienated from women and see them as dominant.

* There is some evidence to suggest that people attribute male or female qualities to certain animals. If this is the case with your man, then the results could well be inconclusive. It’s interesting to note that when women answer these questions they often give pigs and frogs male names because they can’t imagine how such ugly creatures could possibly be female.
